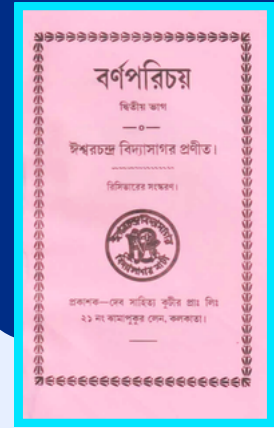

Innovation Hub and Entrepreneurship

The Innovation Hub and Entrepreneurship (IHE) Cell of Vidyasagar University was established in 2025 to promote innovative thinking, interdisciplinary collaboration, and entrepreneurial initiatives within the university. A committee chaired by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Professor Dipak Kumar Kar, oversees the hub's activities, with faculty members from different departments ensuring interdisciplinary participation. During the academic year 2025-26, the Cell organised a Presentation of Innovative Ideas programme on 15 October 2025 for research scholars. Shanaz Begum of the Department of Human Physiology, Krishnendu Mandal of the Department of Microbiology, Rimpa Garai and Payal Ghosh of the Department of History were awarded the first, second and third prizes, respectively. Mousumi Ganguly of the Department of Anthropology was awarded the consolation prize.

Innovative Projects

Innovative projects were sought from the faculty members. Altogether 23 projects were submitted. Through double blind peer reviewing process, the following five projects were selected for implementation in Phase-I:

The projects covered a wide range of topics, including Integrated Fallow Land Management in the Lateritic Zone, Millet Cultivation, Cloud-Based Voice-Controlled Smart Car Parking System, Women's Empowerment, and Jal Jeevan Mission.
- In next phase 25 new Incubation Projects have been sanctioned of Rs 25,000 each in 2026.
- Five Incubation Projects have been selected for Start Up projects of Rs 1 Lakh each in 2026.

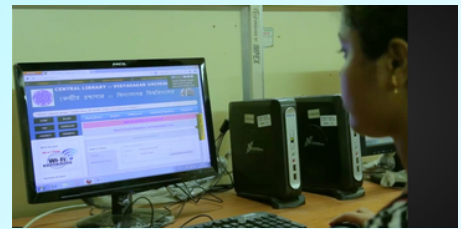

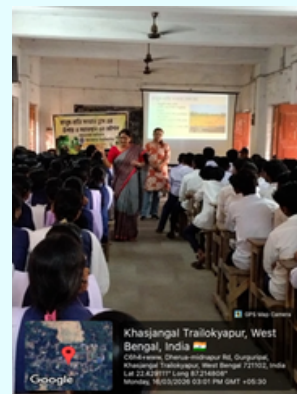
OUTREACH PROGRAMMES

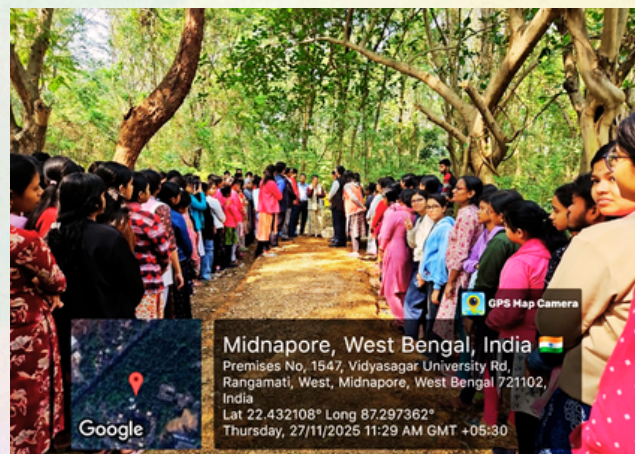

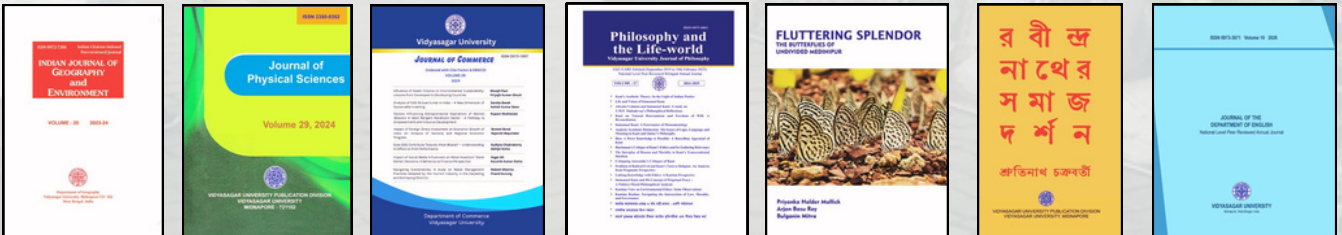
